Dear Parents / Carers

National Schools Breakfast Programme

At Heartsease Primary Academy we are launching a 'Bagel Stop n Grab' in partnership with The National Schools Breakfast Programme.

The programme is aimed to help ensure that children across the country are encouraged to eat breakfast every day before school and will give them the opportunity to have a piece of bagel each morning.

We will be launching the 'Bagel Stop n Grab' outside the school building on Thursday morning from 8:05am to 8:25am. Each child is entitled to a piece of bagel with butter which they can collect from one of our 'Breakfast Monitors'. However, please be aware that although we are encouraging the children to have something to eat, this is optional.

Each child will be given a laminated card that they will present to the 'Breakfast Monitors' in order for them to be able to collect their piece of bagel. They will then need to keep this card safe so they can reuse it each day. If you have a young child in the school, I would suggest that an adult keeps the card and presents it to the monitors in order to lower the risk of losing it. The gates to the playground will be opened earlier in order to let the children move from the front of the school and eat their bagel on the playground before coming into school at 8:30am.

Please note that although the playground will be open, children are not allowed to enter the building until 8:30am and they must also not play on the Pirate Ship as this will not be supervised.

If you would not like your child to collect a piece of bagel, please fill in the slip below and return to school by Wednesday 1st May and we will ensure that they are not given a laminated card.

If your child is allergic to dairy, wheat or gluten that we are not already aware of, please speak to the school office by Wednesday 1st May and we will ensure that they are not given a laminated card.

We are very excited about launching our 'Bagel Stop n Grab'. If you have any questions about it please speak to the school office.
